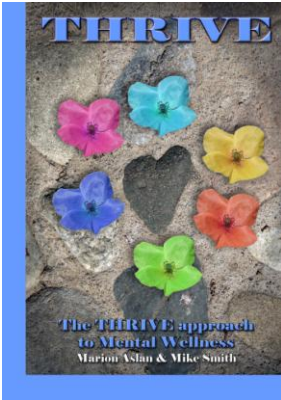


The THRIVE Approach to Recovery and Mental Wellness

“Many people experience severe psychic distress at some point in their life - 1 in 4 of us in the course of a year according to statistics, and at the time it can be totally devastating. Quite apart from the distress this causes to the individual and their loved ones, some people report feeling misunderstood and even frightened by a society which often focuses on illness, deficits, losses and stigmatisation. Many myths and misconceptions still abound regarding psychic distress - not only those held by the general public, but ironically sometimes by those working within mental health systems.

Very often the emphasis is on mental ill health rather than wellness, problems rather than skills, symptoms rather than resilience and despite the concept of recovery being recognised, helping agencies remain predominantly singularly medical in approach and more target driven than people orientated. Sometimes workers feel disempowered, lack confidence or don't fully understand what it is that nurtures recovery.” *Aslan & Smith 2008*

The THRIVE© approach takes a more positive stance. Devised by Mike Smith, a nurse of 25 years experience, Exdirector of Nursing in North Birmingham - and Marion Aslan, a mental health trainer, author and activist who has worked in the learning disabilities and mental health voluntary sector for the last 30 years, they have drawn on their personal and professional experiences of what keeps people maintained within the system and what works in the moving on process, whereby people thrive and find their future. Taking the underpinning elements of Time, Healing, Resilience, Interdependence, Vivacity and Emancipation this book accompanies the individual on their journey to recovery and beyond, instils hope and optimism for a positive future, and enables the person to chart their own course.

The THRIVE Approach focuses on the person's own potential and their capabilities to find solutions for their problems. Using this process, it is about framing your understanding of your experiences”.
